TRACTOR TRAILER REMOVAL & GUARDRAIL REPAIRS REQUIRE INTERSTATE 40 DETOUR IN MONROE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-1) – Removal of a tractor trailer and guardrail repair will require overnight detours on Interstate 40 in Monroe County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will remove a tractor trailer that was involved in a Wednesday afternoon accident at mile marker 206, west of Brinkley. They will also repair a damaged guardrail. The work will require detouring I-40 westbound traffic at mile marker 216 in Brinkley. Drivers will be detoured to Highway 70 westbound. Traffic will then be directed back on Interstate 40 in Biscoe at mile marker 202.

The Interstate 40 westbound detour will be **Sunday night, May 3rd through Tuesday morning, May 5th** between 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., each night, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning/detour signs.
