IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 630 REQUIRE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BAPTIST HEALTH ACCESS RAMPS IN LITTLE ROCK

Detour route provided

LITTLE ROCK (6-17) – Improvements to Interstate 630 will require the temporary closure of Baptist Health access ramps. However, a detour route is provided, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will remove a temporary barrier wall and install pavement markings. The work will require closing the Interstate 630 eastbound and Interstate 430 northbound access ramps to Baptist Health. Drivers will be detoured east on Interstate 630 to John Barrow Road. They can then travel north over Interstate 630 and return to the Interstate 630 westbound access ramp to Baptist Health (detour map is attached).

The closures will be **Saturday, June 20th between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.**, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning/detour signs.
